Outline of Business Results

While the economy of emerging countries have developed, the uncertainty over the future course of the world economy increased during this period due to financial uneasiness triggered by the subprime loan crisis in developed countries as well as the rising price of crude oil and materials and uncertainty of the foreign exchange market. Additionally, there is a concern in the domestic market that pressure is placed on corporate profits due to factors including increased procurement cost and a sharp appreciation of the yen.

The domestic amusement (pachinko) market continues to face a severe business environment with an unprecedented degree of environmental deterioration of the market, such as a significant decrease in new openings and large-scale remodeling of pachinko halls and a decline in the number of pachinko players, causing a reduction of pachinko halls. Meanwhile, the overseas gaming market, the core market of JCM, continued to expand and replacement demand has been boosted with the amendment of gaming laws in Germany. Moreover, in Eastern Europe in addition to the expansion of the gaming market, the commercial market has expanded with economic growth.

Under such a management environment, the JCM Group concentrated management resources on its core field and growth areas, moved forward to selection and focus of business by withdrawing from less profitable markets, and focused on a new product plan with its own technology.

Despite these efforts, net sales decreased by 10.2 % to ¥28,543 million, operating income dropped by 17% to ¥2,849 million, ordinary income declined by 23% to ¥2,846 million, and net income fell by 91 % to ¥157 million from the same period of the previous year, adversely affected largely by a sales decline in the domestic amusement industry.

The details of ¥1,392 million of the total extraordinary expenses were ¥831 million of bad debt loss, ¥318 million of loss on devaluation of investment in securities, ¥88 million of transfer to allowance for doubtful accounts, ¥71 million of transfer to provision for loss on dissolution of affiliates, ¥72 million of loss on disposal of fixed assets. Due to net loss on nonconsolidated financial results, there is low possibility of collection of deferred income taxes. Therefore, ¥ 990 million of deferred income has been unpled.

In foreign exchange rates, the average yen to US dollar exchange rate was ¥117.71/\$1 compared to 116.39/\$1 in the same period of the previous year, and the average against the euro was ¥162/€ compared to ¥146.89/€ in the same period of the previous year.

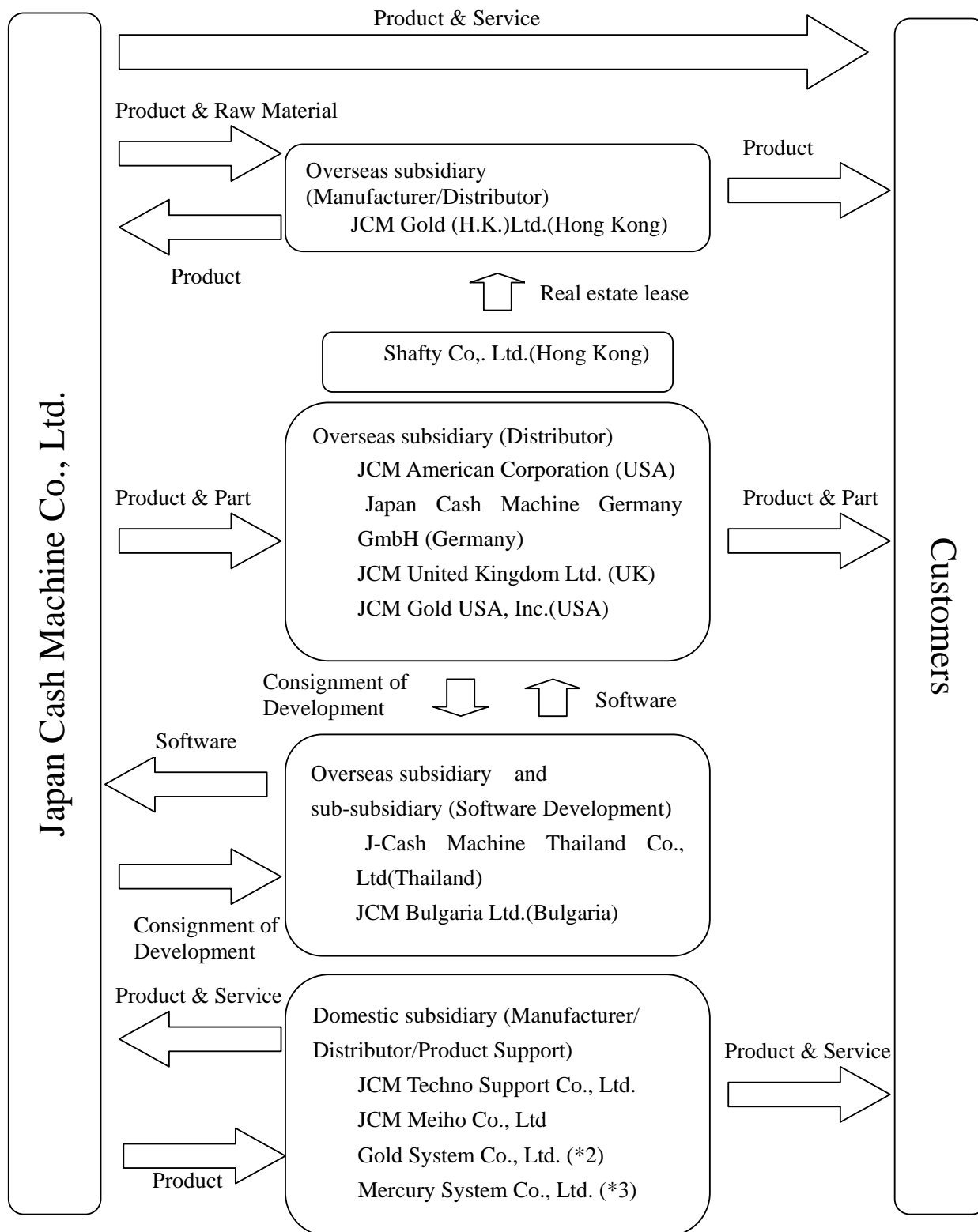
